What data we collect

Aside from 'cookies' which are outlined in a separate section. We also collect personal data as a result of creating an account with us. Some of the account data we collect when you create an account on our site includes but is not limited to:

Please note that your name and username are the only two required fields that are published on the site. This is to allow for users to communicate with each other as well as find friends easier. Your email will only be accessible to the site's owner and site manager. Your password will be stored on the server but can only be accessed by the site owner.

We also use a number of plugins across the site to enhance your experience with us. Some of these plugins also collect data which is also collected by us and in some cases the plugin creators themselves (e.g. Google Analytics). The data we receive from these plugins is as follows:

Where your data is stored

Your data is stored securely on our hosting servers provided by HostPresto as well as backed up daily and weekly to our online storage system. We are also in the process of securing an SSL (Secure Sockets Layer) certificate to maximise the security of your data.

What we do with your data

Most of the data you have provided is used to allow you to create an account and use the various features across our site such as our football predictor.

We don't sell your personal data to any third party providers. Any of the data you have provided will not be sold on. Although we have no plans for this to change, if things were to

change then we would contact you immediately. Equally any data provided before that point would have to be verified by you for that use, so rest assured none of your data which you use today would be used without explicit permission.

Cookies are used by parties such as Google AdSense to provide adverts tailored to you based on your cookies. Check out their privacy policy below but they won't collect any personal data from you from these adverts, just simply the cookie.

How can you access your data?


You can access parts of your data by clicking on your profile on the site. Although that will not display data such as login IP's which are stored specifically on 'backend' (the admin side) of the website.

In order to access any of the data stored on the 'backend' such as IPS, please get in direct contact with us at Support@HalfTimeCuppa.com and we will gladly provide you with the data we have stored within a 4 week time window.

How can you edit or erase your data?

You can edit your data by either clicking on your 'profile' and clicking either 'settings' or 'profile' depending on what you are trying to edit. Alternatively, should you need any specific help with editing your data, please email Support@HalfTimeCuppa.com who will guide you through the process.

Erasing your data can be done in two ways. You can delete your account anytime by going to your 'profile' and by clicking on 'settings' from there you will see an option labelled 'Delete account'. This will delete your account from our system. Alternatively, should you wish for us to delete your account for you, please email Support@HalfTimeCuppa.com directly.



Who can access my data?

Your data is securely stored on our server and is only accessible to the site owner and the site manager. All our staff team understand the need to protect privacy and are required to ensure that data remains private. All staff have signed a data protection contract. Although as mentioned it's only the two highest positions available on the site that will have access to the data.

Should the scale of our operation increase then this may well change, but you will be notified well in advance of any alteration.

Data breaches

In the event of a data breach, we will inform all user that are affected as well as the Information Commissioners Offices. Although we hope with the measures in place this will never be the case.

What happens to my data if owners change?

All data currently collected across the site will be transferred over to the new site owner. Although that data will only be used for the purpose collected and cannot be used for anything else without your permission. The new owner would be notified prior to the transfer.

Cookies

Cookies may be stored on our server. However, these are mainly used for marketing reasons. This information could only accessible internally by the site owner. Cookies are therefore mainly used by plugins and third parties such as Google AdSense who use cookies to display adverts best suited for you.

Cookies that are collected by us are used for your convenience, e.g. if you tick 'remember me' your login will persist for two weeks, but if you were to log out the login cookies will be removed. If you were to leave a comment on the site whether you were logged in or not you may opt-in to saving your name, email address and website in your cookies. This is used to save you time from entering the same details in. This type of cookie can last for one year.
